- The bugle is often played at military funerals and on Remembrance Day, to symbolize that soldiers can rest in peace. In war, the bugle was used to tell soldiers it was time to return to their barracks and sleep.

Winter Wear

ARE YOU MOVING? INTERNAL TRANSFER PROCESS

If your family is moving to a home that is outside the boundary of your student's current campus, your student may remain at that campus, but you will be responsible for transportation to and from school. Bussing is not available outside the designated campus boundaries. If you require transportation, you will need to apply for an internal transfer to the campus designated for your new address. Apply by March 1, 2024 to have the best chance of being considered for the 2024/25 year. The transfer request applications are processed through the Online Waitlist system. Internal transfer Requests will precede most waitlist students (including priority status and siblings). If the requested campus is unable to accommodate your student, the current campus will hold a seat to ensure the registration is guaranteed. Please see the following link for the instructions to request a transfer.

Please note:

- transfers do not occur mid-year
- transfers can only occur if a seat becomes available in the requested campus (possible wait of 5+ years)
- we may not be able to accommodate all children in the same family in the same year

IMPORTANT BUS REMINDERS



-  When dropping off or picking your child up at the bus stop, you must be there at your stop **at least 5 minutes** before the bus arrives both in the am and pm.
-  **NO PARKING** in bus zones at the bus stops or at the school.
-  Your child must be out of the car before the bus arrives at your stop so that everyone can board the bus quickly.
-  Please ensure that you sign up for the bus delays



WHERE'S MY BUS?

FAMILY BUS BROADCAST SUBSCRIPTIONS - SOUTHLAND ROUTES

If your child rides the bus, please sign up for our monitoring system. All of our Southland buses have GPS units installed so you will be able to see where your child's bus is at any point during its scheduled route. If there is a substitute bus due to mechanical issues, you will not be able to see where the bus is, but you will still see expected delays and dispatch comments. The code for your campus is available on Edsby. Ensure you add the AM and PM routes if your child rides two-way. - One full day is being covered by the NEE Casino Society!
- Parents pay \$57.04 (includes bussing, cost of the lesson and all ski equipment for both days).

Schedule:

- Students will leave the school at approximately 9:30am and return to NEE at approximately 2:45pm.
- Lunch will be eaten in the ski lodge at Canada Olympic Park.
- Students will have two hours of instruction with a qualified Winsport instructor.

Parent Information:

- Students will receive lessons at their ability level (skill level).
- Students will review the Alpine Safety Expectations in P.E. class prior to the field trip.

Volunteers Needed:

- Many volunteers are required to help on this day. Parents do not need to know how to ski.
- If you are interested in volunteering, please email me: Melissa.brooks@FFCA-Calgary.com
- Volunteers can ride the bus with the students to and from NEE OR meet us at the ski hill.
- Volunteers will assist the students to put on and take off equipment and be available to help students during the day on the training hill).

What to wear during lessons:

- Students need to be dressed appropriately for the weather.
- Two layers of athletic clothes (example: undershirt and sweater, leggings under sweatpants)
- Warm winter outer gear (winter jacket and snow pants)
- Winter hat and neck warmer
- Mittens or gloves (thick warm, water-resistant ones)
- Socks (do not wear multiple pairs of socks as that is more likely to cause blisters)

What to pack:

- An extra pair of mittens or gloves
- A large, nut free snack
- A large, healthy **NUT FREE** lunch– **No** microwaves available – Students will **NOT** be allowed to purchase food items.
- A water bottle

Waitlist Application Renewal NOVEMBER 1—30, Annually

IMPORTANT: If you have an address or grade change to make, see the RENEWAL FAQs on the website or [click here](#).

You can renew your application by following these steps:


- Go to the FFCA website, www.ffca-calgary.com. Scroll down and click on the Waitlist Quick link
- Go to the [Online Waitlist System](#) link
 - Enter your email address (ID) and your password
 - If you cannot remember your password, click on “Forgot Your Password?”, enter your email address and answer your challenge question. An email will be sent to you with your new password.
- Click on the Update and Renewal Gateway.
- You should see your child/ren listed. The status does NOT mean anything. **Please ignore it!!**
- Click on the [Update/Renew](#) link
 - Confirm your information on each screen. Fields with a red asterisk are required.
 - You cannot change your child’s name, date of birth or gender. You’ll need to upload a picture of either the birth certificate or name change certificate, then email the waitlist coordinator with the requested change.
- To update your address, click Yes below your old address
 - Enter your new address, then upload an Address Verification Document
 - You are required to provide Home Address Verification. All documentation must be uploaded by November 30th to complete the renewal AND have your child included in the upcoming year’s admission process.
- To update your student’s grade, click No below the listed grade and enter the grade you are applying for.
 - Upload a report card for grade verification by November 30th to complete the renewal.
- Enter the sibling information IF the students are actual siblings and one student currently attends an FFCA campus.
- Now you will do the actual renewal on page 60-79%.
- Enter your electronic signature and click “I confirm” to agree that all your account information is correct and you want to Renew the application for the coming school year.
- Click Save and Next
- Confirm that you have completed this student
- Now click Continue, and you will see a pop-up with further information
- You will receive a confirmation email shortly from registration.FoundationsAB@registrationgateway.net
 - Please add that email to your address book so that it isn’t sent to your junk mail or blocked entirely (especially if you use Gmail)
 - Each student will receive an individual confirmation email
 - If you change your address or student’s grade, you will receive an email once the documents have been verified. That could take weeks. The date/time that you complete the renewal will be recorded in the timestamp, not the date/time that the documents have been verified.
- You will now be redirected back to the list of your students. The status will say “Pending,” but that does not mean you haven’t completed the renewal. Additionally, when you log back in, it will likely say Your Action Needed. **Please ignore the status!**
- If you have more than one child, continue to the next child to renew the application until all your children have been renewed.
- Click Logout
